

Lack of demand due to COVID and a Saudi-Russian price war drove down crude oil to a negative rate; that meant that if you had a place to store it, you could've had a supertankers' worth of oil for free. The Trump administration brokered a peace treaty between Israel and the United Arab Emirates, Sudan, Bahrain, and Morocco. By excluding the Palestinians (who have sabotaged every peace deal in the past 50 years) from negotiations the blueprint for a more civilized Middle East is now apparent.

House democrats set a terrible precedent when they impeached President Trump because they disagreed with his policies and simply could not stand him. Not one partisan government official that the House "intelligence" committee paraded out as a bombshell witness claimed that the President did anything illegal or that rose to the standard of 'high crimes and misdemeanors' necessary for impeachment. The entrenched, do nothing, lifelong bureaucrat "witnesses" all just disagreed with Trump's foreign policy.

A Mars rover, Perseverance, was launched this year; it'll take core samples on the planet that will be returned to Earth in 2028. The rover carries a small helicopter that will be the first machine to fly on another planet. A different American spacecraft, OSIRIS-REx, touched down on an asteroid and scooped up a sample of it. And, Jupiter and Saturn are in conjunction now; this is the closest the two planets have appeared in the night sky since the year 1623.





Scientists have built machines that can extract oxygen and hydrogen from the regolith that covers the surface of the moon to make drinking water, breathable air, and rocket fuel. A new race to the moon is heating up with BlueOrigin (Jeff Bezos' company) and SpaceX leading the way. The plan is for the first woman, an American woman, to walk on the lunar surface in 2024.

I was fortunate enough to witness a number of SpaceX launches this year. For the first time since the shuttle program was retired back in 2011, astronauts were sent into orbit (twice) from Cape Canaveral. Elon Musk launched his massive Starship; its designed to carry dozens of people at a time and will eventually ferry the first colonist to Mars. SpaceX also launched a number of rockets each carrying 60 small Starlink satellites that'll provide worldwide internet service. All routine ended with COVID starting in March. Trump suspended travel from Asia & Europe and closed the borders with Canada & Mexico. Other nations followed suit. Airlines cancelled flights worldwide, with a 13% drop, the Dow Jones had its biggest one-day loss in history, and Japan postponed the 2020 Olympics. Schools were closed, businesses were shuttered, and government buildings locked their doors. Tyrannical ruler's shut down California and New York for most of the year. People were arrested for simply walking on a deserted trail or surfing alone in the ocean. After months of lockdowns, small business owners, on the verge of insolvency and with no other choice, opened their doors only to be fined into bankruptcy or jailed by a totalitarian government. More pragmatic leaders in Texas and Florida kept their states largely open and saw no significant differences in the number of COVID cases.

Trump initiated Operation Warp Speed which produced vaccines in partnership with pharmaceutical companies. Just ten months after COVID hit the U.S., millions are now being inoculated with estimates that ~100 million Americans will be immunized by April. Every one of these iron-fisted rulers demanding subservience and ordering us to self-imprison is a Democrat.
